## LOFTY AMBITIONS

One thing is for sure: Elysee Miami is a property that wants to be noticed. Destined to become the tallest residential tower in East Edgewater when its doors open in mid-2018 (at 700 NE 23rd St., Miami), the building, designed by Arquitectonica and produced by Two Roads Development, will scale 57 stories. The glass-wrapped structure appears to almost telescope from the top, where a singular penthouse (yet to be priced) sits. The waterfront building's other 99 residences range in size from three bedrooms starting at 2,660 square feet to five bedrooms at 4,000 square feet, but only a maximum of two condos share each floor, with prices ranging from $\$ 1.65$ million to more than $\$ 10$ million.
